

PCHC SB CANDIDATE SURVEY QUESTIONS #2

This is a list of questions that could be used in a survey sent to School Board candidates. The answers or non-answers then can be put to use on a voter guide to be handed out at the polls and other places. These answers also may be used in newspaper ad. Recommend using about 15-20 questions to ask all the candidates in a survey sent to them and then to use about 5-10 of those answers on a voter guide that demonstrate the different opinions of the candidates. The NONPARTISAN voter guide can be handed out at the poll and other places (like churches) and used in your nonpartisan group public education effort. The questions are worded such that those who agree with our positions will likely view a “support” answer positively. The majority of the questions are support/undecided/oppose choices with any explanations of an answer put on our web site for viewing. The last few questions are yes or no questions.

The questions used should take into consideration how the local community (conservative or liberal) will react to them. We are looking to build voting support for the candidates we feel best reflect our values and will protect our children.

Parents/guardians have the primary responsibility and authority over their child's education

Tax dollars should follow the student if parent decides to move child to a charter school or private school.

Parents should be required to give permission (opt-in) for the sexual education of their children.

Schools should require parental consent (opt in) to teach children graphic sexualization (Comprehensive Sexuality Education).

Parental/guardian consent should be required in order to refer students for hormonal contraception.

Parents should be notified (opt-in) when there is to be a classroom discussion about sexual orientation and gender identity.

Children should be protected from exposure to pornography in the schools.

Teens should be encouraged to avoid sex, just as they are encouraged to avoid other risks, such as smoking and underage drinking.

Other than defining and describing contraceptives, children should not receive explicit instructions from the school on how to use condoms and birth control.

Consensual sex, even with the use of contraception, does not make sexual activity among minor children acceptable.

Teaching school children that abortion is a form of birth control is unacceptable.

Children should not be taught specific sex acts as part of sex education.

Schools should not teach children that they have rights to sexual pleasures.

The biological sex of the student should be the sole determining factor for using the restrooms and locker rooms at school.

No biologic males should be allowed in restrooms and locker rooms with females

A student in the process of transitioning to a different gender should be barred from competing in school sports.

Children should not be taught that homosexual behavior is normal and acceptable.

School board meetings should open with prayer

Religious Liberty is not bigotry

Sex education should not be taught outside health classes

Students should compete in sports according to their biological sex

Biologic females receiving male hormones should not compete in female sports

Suggesting to children that they can choose their Gender is child abuse

Gender Identity is a social experiment with devastating and permanent effects on children

Students should not be given demonstrations and practice placing condoms on models

Teaching about anal sex has no place in the classroom

Books promoting homosexual behavior should not be used in school

Homosexual experimentation should not be encouraged in our schools

Pornography and explicit sex content should not be available through school web sites

Social Emotional Learning (SLE) to teach “values” is brainwashing children and should not be in schools

Schools should recognize only male and female genders
